Inspector General Functions

- **Assistance (Ombudsman role)**
 - *To aid personnel denied due process*
 - *To examine our “systems” to ensure they work properly*
- **Investigations**
 - *As directed by the COM or DCOM*
 - *As required (Hotline and Whistleblower)*
- **Inspections**
 - *Checking systems and functions*
 - *To answer specific questions*
- **Teach and Train**
 - *In all of our activities*
 - *Basic IG theater security cooperation task*
- **Intelligence Oversight**
 - *Task mandated by presidential executive order*
 - *Receiving more attention & requiring more activity*

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IG Outreach

Using the IG model for theater security cooperation

Focus: *Building partner capacity* for good governance and rule of law. Show IG as means to enforce standards, address fraud, and assist troops

Guidance:

- **Secretary of Defense Gates:** “Where possible, our strategy is to employ indirect approaches - primarily through building the capacity of partner governments and their security forces...”
- **Admiral Stavridis:** “I want to work hard on developing partnership capacity with our friends throughout the region; conducting effective operations across the spectrum of activity and throughout the region...”
- **DoD TSC guidance** emphasizes addressing corruption and fraud in countries where we conduct theater security cooperation.

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Trafficking in Persons

- Trafficking in persons:
 - Recruitment, transportation, transfer, harboring or receipt of persons by means of threats, use of force, coercion, abduction, fraud, deception, abuse or exploitation
 - TIP = world's third largest and fastest growing criminal activity.
- TIP is:
 - A grave violation of human rights and a worldwide criminal threat to security, civil rights, and stability.
 - Supported by illegal activities such as prostitution which aren't tolerated in DoD and the US European Command.
